Brandon Wade Ho was born in Redwood City, California in 1985. His parents owned their own company and eventually moved to Colorado. Homeschooled from 1st grade and up, his mom taught him to teach himself and he was self-sufficient in his education by the age of 12.

Brandon started making home-made movies with his friends throughout his teenage years, his biggest project being a 45 minute Christmas musical that took 3 months to produce. After putting in 80 hours in one week to finish post-production, he decided that this was something he should pursue for a career.

After spending 2 years on a service project for his church in Argentina, Brandon went to Brigham Young University to study film. The Director's Track allowed him to direct a capstone film project, My Hero, which won the prestigious College Television Award for Best Children's Programming which was hosted by the Emmy's Foundation.

After graduating, he started working for the LDS Motion Picture Studio. He directed his first feature film, Missed Connections, and wrapped up the last day of production in the hospital for the birth of his first child
